Position	Team Leader (2 manmonths). Team of two EU experts, the other an atmospheric computer modelling expert.
Description	This European Commission funded multi-disciplinary project aimed at enhancing Indian high level officials' appreciation of the potential win-win benefits from integrating climate change policies and air quality/health policies and to achieve improved institutional capacity at research institutions working with climate modelling. Through dialogues with the high level officials, other key Indian stakeholders, and European centres of excellence, the project assessed the Indian capacities to monitor atmospheric pollution from large industrial and power generation sources, and designed pilot projects to strengthen monitoring and reporting capacity for atmospheric emissions from those sectors in India and to demonstrate the win-win potentials.
